Application report

Medical history:

67-year-old male patient after big toe amputation. The interdigital spaces have also been affected by pressure and show small but permanent wounds.



Why the decision for MOMOSAN?

The larger wound was permanently covered by fibrinous tissue. This had to be prevented permanently without the need to increase the dressing change interval, and in order to be able to continue with moist wound healing. The interdigital spaces had previously been treated with fleece compresses that always stuck to the wounds.

Problem solution:

Tamponade using thin MOMOSAN white that is ideally suited for insertion and tamponing.

Further course of treatment:

Due to the drainage effect of MOMOSAN, the interdigital spaces dried within two weeks. The coatings on the wound have not reoccurred since then.
