Application report

**Medical history:**

62-year-old female patient suffering from diabetic foot syndrome. Wound after bruise on the right big toe. The hyperkeratotic tissue is removed on a regular basis. The bandage is applied by the patient herself.



**Why the decision for MOMOSAN?**

To improve pressure relief and prevent wound maceration.

**Problem solution:**

A MOMOSAN white 5x5x1 dressing is cut to size, and the patient is instructed on how to change the dressing professionally and hygienically. A soft and absorbing bandage is applied secondarily.

**Further course of treatment:**

The amount of hyperkeratotic tissue has clearly decreased, hence resulting in reduced dressing change intervals in the surgery.
