

Patient: Forefoot phlegmon as a result of polyneuropathy in diabetes



Forefoot phlegmon: preoperative diagnosis: inpatient admission due to burning of the big toe on the other foot on heating pad.



First postoperative day. Soft tissue necrosis on the back of the foot between the incision sites.



Diagnosis after resection of the areas of necrosis on the back of the foot with exposed extensor tendon bed.



Distinctive fibrin coating in the area of the soft tissue defect.



Another dressing change with MOMOSAN white.



Pocket after abscess cavity medial towards the ankle joint.



Subsequently, good granulation tissue formation.



Another dressing change with MOMOSAN white with lining of the wound cavity.
